WHEREAS, Council Member Thomas Hoehn resigned his position as Council Member for Ward 3, Position 1 and the Council confirmed his resignation November 14, 2017, and

WHEREAS, there is more than one year remaining on former Council Member Hoehn's term, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bentonville has a population according to the most recent Federal decennial census of more than 20,000,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BENTONVILLE, ARKANSAS THAT:


Section. 1. The Council has determined that former Council Member Hoehn's position shall be filled by special election to occur on March 13, 2018, with the filing period to begin on December 1, 2017 and to end at 12:00 Noon on December 22, 2017, subject to confirmation of those dates by the County Clerk of Benton County, and with such other procedures related to the election to be determined by the County Clerk of Benton County, the Benton County Election Commission, and any other appropriate officials according to law. The dates listed herein shall be subject to being reset by the described officials to comply with the law so that the special election can be conducted at the earliest practical date.
